The MUGA HAS LANDED !!

It's for all ages, and youngsters are already making the most of the new multi-use games area, upgraded from the poor old tennis courts after Groundwork helped FFG secure funding of £38,000 from Sport England, topped up by Torbay Council to £41,000. A football coaching evening was held in February, and FFG has now received confirmation of a grant of £4,750 from the Local Network Fund (Devon Community Foundation) for coaching in football, tennis and basketball. Details of how to apply will be available shortly.

The 'shipwreck' will be 'washed ashore' this year, we hope, now that the funding has been awarded to us- £13,900 from the Big Lottery Fund and £17,000 from Torbay Council. Another bid has already been submitted to the BLF for stages 2 and 3-for the toddlers and teenagers-of FFG's master plan for play. If that is not successful a direct fundraising campaign will be launched to complete the project. All ideas welcome.
